# WORSHIP

## From the Parochial Vicar

### The Importance of the Tabernacle in the Catholic Religion

Having discussed last week the origin and significance of the tabernacle, we now move on to the placement of the tabernacle within a church, chapel, or oratory. There are five requirements to consider when placing a tabernacle in a church. These requirements or criteria are found in the Code of Canon Law, Canon 938, and the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, GIRM 314.

(1)The first requirement is that the tabernacle is located in a distinguished or truly noble area. The area in which the tabernacle is placed needs to be a space that is noteworthy as it exists for no other purpose than housing Our Lord Jesus Christ. It cannot be on the main altar, but it can be placed on an unused altar, such as a high altar. (2)The second requirement is that the place the tabernacle is placed is both conspicuous/prominent. This means that the tabernacle stands out so that it is clearly visible, meaning easily seen, and that it attracts the notice of those who enter the Church. (3)The third requirement is that the area is beautifully/worthily decorated. The area where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved should be decorated in such a manner that signifies Christ's regal dignity, and that it has tasteful signs of the faithful's devotion, such as flowers, precious metal gilding, or beautiful stone/wood structures surrounding it. (4) Fourth, the place the tabernacle is located must be suitable for prayer. This means that there should be space before the tabernacle where the faithful can kneel and sit before the Most Blessed Sacrament in quiet prayer for prolonged periods of time. If the tabernacle is in the center of the church, in an elevated and visible position, this means the pews are the place of prayer. If the tabernacle is located somewhere else in the Church, like in a side chapel, this means there must be space for people to pray. (5) Finally, the tabernacle and the space it is in must be blessed. Before the tabernacle is put into use it should be blessed with the appropriate ritual.

Next week, we will discuss the requirements that the tabernacle itself must stand up to in order to be deemed fit for use as an actual tabernacle.
