## From the Parochial Vicar The Importance of the Tabernacle in the Catholic Religion

The Presider's Chair

For the last three weeks I have been writing about the tabernacle, its origin, placement within the church, and how it is to be built. By now you see that the tabernacle in our own parish has been rightfully moved to the center of the sanctuary, making Jesus truly the center of the church, our devotion, and attention. As a result of this the presider's chair (where the priest sits) and the deacon's chairs have been moved. So what does the Church teach about this piece of furniture in the sanctuary?

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (#310) states that "the chair of the Priest Celebrant must signify his function of presiding over the gathering and of directing the prayer." This means that the placement of the presider's chair, to the degree the church design allows, needs to be in such a place that it is clear that the priest is directing or leading the people into the true worship of God. The placement of the presider's chair, and that of the deacons, must avoid "any appearance of a throne," and should be separate from the seating of any lay ministers who may be seated in the sanctuary (lectors and servers). Furthermore, there needs to be sufficient seating for priest concelebrants near the altar on those occasions multiple priests are celebrating the Divine Liturgy together.

By moving the tabernacle to the center, we have removed the throne-like presider chair that has been in place for many years. This has allowed us in a sense to enthrone Jesus Christ as the center of our parish/worship, and I believe it will make a great difference in the spiritual life of our faith community here at Holy Name. May God bless you!

The Protecting God's Children® Program for Adults teaches clergy, diocesan / parish / school / agency employees, volunteers, parents and other caring adults to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and to respond appropriately.

Effective July 11, 2022 in-person training sessions are offered weekly at the Pastoral Center in Springfield, Massachusetts on the following days and times:

- **1:00 PM – Second and Fourth Thursday of Each Month**
- **6:00 PM – Second Thursday of Each Month**
