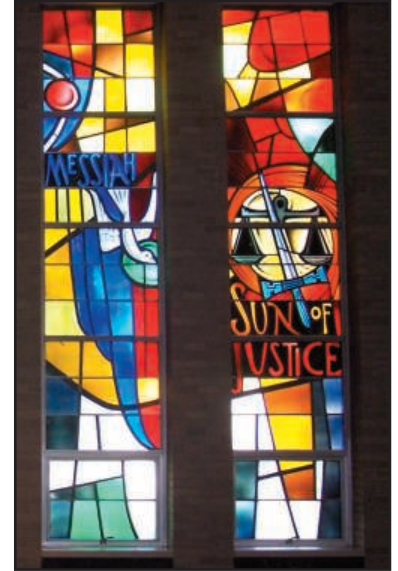

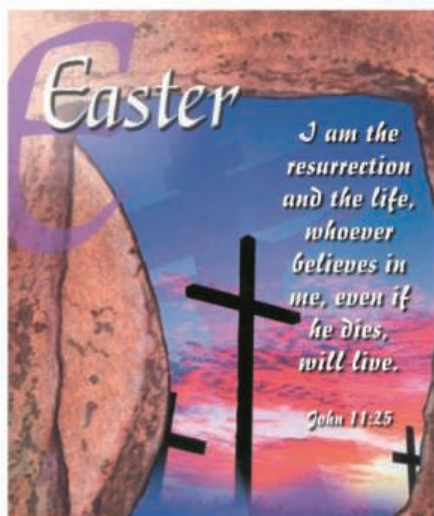

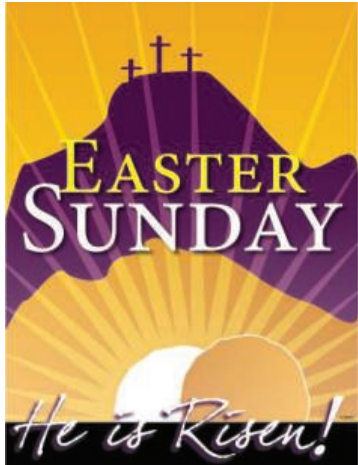

Dear Friends,

Christus Resurrexit! Resurrexit Sicut Dixit! Christ is Risen! He is Risen as He Said!
