

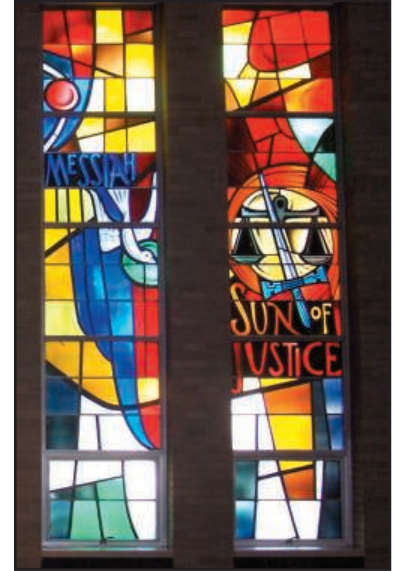

The Mom of ALL Moms ... the Blessed Virgin Mary. In the prologue of St. John's Gospel, he writes: "the word became flesh..." And who provided the flesh but none other than Mary.
