

All are invited to our Sunday, January 7th Epiphany "THREE KINGS" Celebration taking place in the Social Center from 2:00-5:00p.m. There will be food, music, and gifts for the children (whose parents have signed them up). Again, we are asking for a good will donation (to cover the cost of the food) instead of selling tickets. Thank you for your understanding and generosity.

The book for the 2024 Mass Intentions is now open. Emails are preferred, but if unavailable, you can call the rectory. As always, you are welcome to schedule three weekend Masses; weekday Masses are unlimited.

### REMEMBERING THE HOMEBOUND AT CHRISTMASTIME

We have parishioners who are homebound, and if you are interested in either sending them a note or card, calling them to chat, or visiting (with\* or without a gift), their contact information is in a basket at the parking lot entrance. You have until January 7<sup>th</sup> (a.k.a. known as "Little Christmas" - The Epiphany) to reach out. Or, if there are names that weren't chosen, you could do a "Happy New Year" reach out instead. We understand that Christmas time is very busy, so a note for the New Year would also be a kind gesture during a less busy time. Thanks for considering this as an alternative.

\*Candies are always a hit, or some hand crème, or pens, stamps, note cards, and the like. Perhaps a call prior to a visit would be best, to ensure what you are thinking of bringing will work best.

There will be a *Bible Study* with Sr. Leila on the first Tuesday of each month starting in January (so it would be January 2<sup>nd</sup>) from 10-10:45a.m. in the church. We will be studying the Beatitudes. Everyone is welcomed to come.


