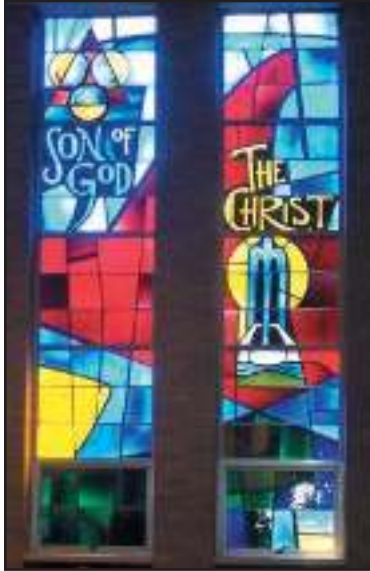

## WORSHIP



### *From Your Parish Administrator*

Having celebrated Jesus being Baptized in the River Jordan on January 8th, 2024 we concluded Christmastide. We are back to Ordinary Time. We will follow the Readings for seven weeks praying through Lent. Jesus invites two disciples Simon Peter and Andrew in John's Gospel. The words He uses are, Come and see. Besides that way of calling, the First Reading presents to us the gentle calling of God to Samuel, waking him up, is the same voice waking us up to just who God says we are. We are not ordinary in God's way of seeing and God invites us to see God's ways. What we are invited to in Christ is a holy mentality. Paul puts it very clearly in our Second Reading, Do you know that your body is the Temple of the Holy spirit within you, which you have from God and that you are not your own. Therefore glorify God in your body.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** Tuesdays, 1-5p.m., Chaplet prayed at 3p.m., Rosary at 4:30p.m. followed by Benediction. There is a new set of Adoration Volunteer sign-ups sheets. Thank you for your kindness in making sure there is always someone here in church during Adoration time.

**Note:** During the winter season, if the Springfield Public Schools are closed on a Tuesday due to weather related issues, Adoration will be canceled for that day.

Just a reminder there is a **Bible Study** with Sr. Leila on the first Tuesday of the month from 10-10:45a.m. in the church. We will be studying the Beatitudes. Everyone is welcomed to attend, no sign-up is necessary.

An FYI, when trying to reach a priest in an emergency situation to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
