# From Your Parish Administrator

This Sunday's First Reading pictures God promising never to flood the earth again with water, even though there may be a reason for God to be angry. When God sees the unprepared and unresponsive human family, God promises also to see a rainbow which will be the covenantal sign of God's everlasting love and mercy.

The Second Reading is a baptismal instruction to those baptized recently. As Noah was saved from the waters of destruction being in the Ark, those who have been baptized in the flood-waters of Christ are saved by being in the ark of Christ.

The Gospel pictures Jesus being lead out into the desert for forty days and then returning to proclaim that," the Kingdom of God is at hand". Jesus, as did the Jews before Him, was lead out to face Himself and His Demons. The Jews wandered for forty years facing themselves and whether they believed and trusted in God's care.

We have begun our forty-day prayer journey. It is time to face ourselves and our demons. It is time for seeing if we are doing what is good for us and whether we know what is good for us, at all. We could give up doing things which are harmful to our spirits as well as our bodies and our relationships. As well, we could spend these days doing actions of charity which are both good for others and very good for our souls. We are a Church into which others want to come and pray and live out our faith with us.

### **DIOCESE OF SPRINGFIELD 2024 LENTEN REGULATIONS**

- 1. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- 2. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- 3. The obligation to abstain from meat begins at age fourteen (14) and does not cease.
- 4. The obligation to fast begins at age eighteen (18) and ends at age fifty-nine (59).

<u>Please note</u>: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse him/herself from these Lenten obligations.

### First Sunday of Lent -- February 18, 2024

"I establish My covenant with you." If in your listening to the Lord you are sensing the invitation to follow Christ as a priest, sister, or brother, talk to your priest or reach out to the Vocation Office at 413-248-7034 or via email: vocations@diospringfield.org.

An FYI, when trying to reach a priest in an emergency situation to administer the Sacrament of the Sick for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
