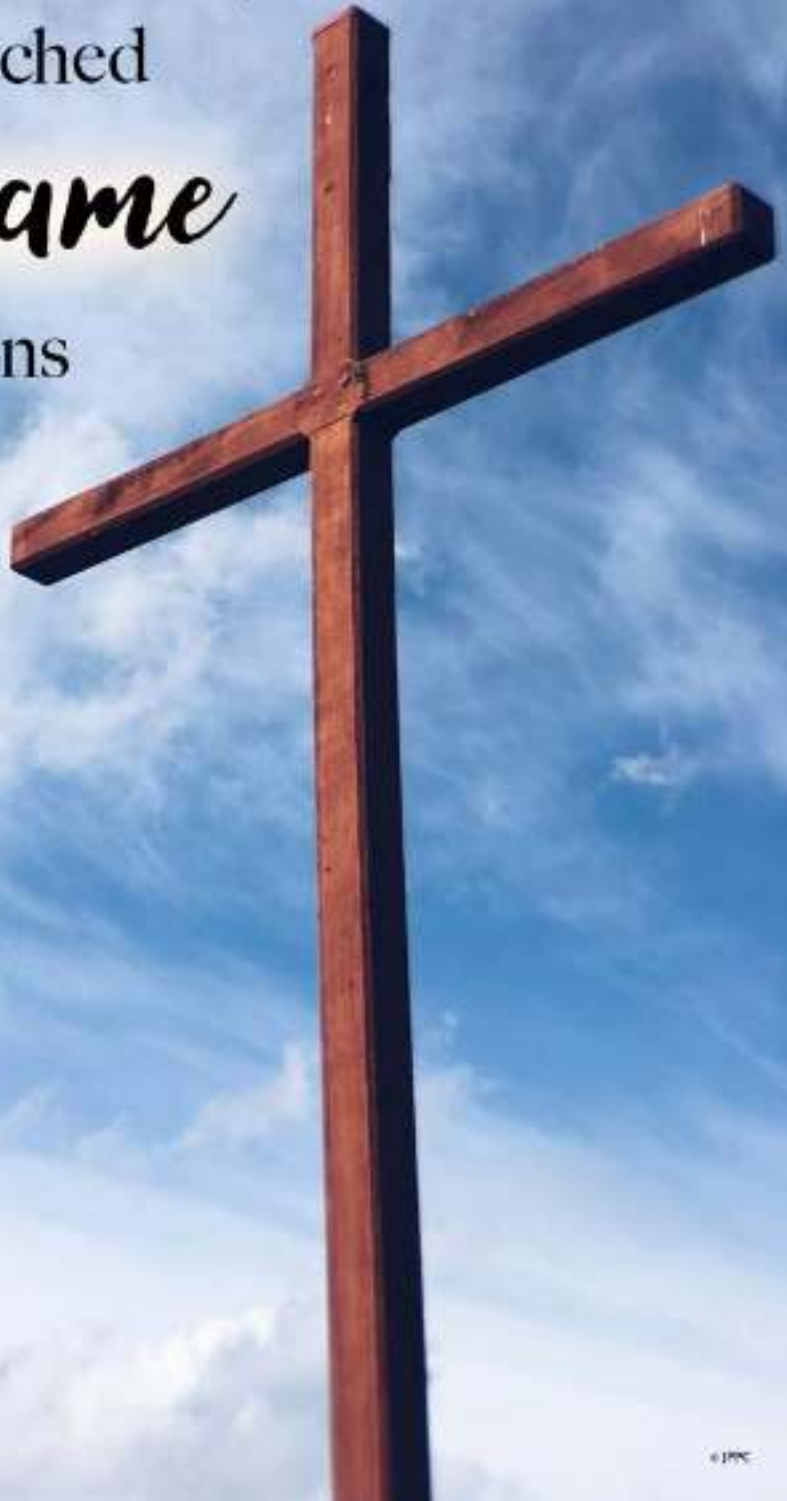

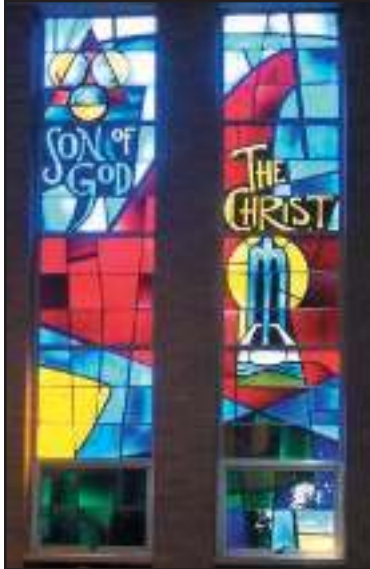

From Your Parish Administrator

I like the Alleluia verse that stated, "Were not our hearts burning within us". So my question gets to become, how do I get my own heart burning for the Lord? We have just gone through another desert of Lent, Holy Week and still experiencing the spiritual effects of Easter. Since my Catholic Catechism days, my experience has been I am growing slowly and steadily into it.

In today's Gospel, the disciples at first thought that they were seeing a ghost, not the risen Christ. This comes from some of the disciples, who actually saw the empty tomb. For us at times to have a lack of fire is only natural. This is understandable since the witnesses themselves were lacking an abundance of faith. I do not have the luxury of firsthand knowledge, yet my faith continues to blossom and the flame is stronger by the day and now what is your take on this in your faith journey?

"Peace be with you." His peace will be fully felt when you are living the vocation that he has called you to. Eucharistic Adoration: Tuesdays, 1-5p.m., Chaplet prayed at 3p.m., Rosary at 4:30p.m. followed by Benediction. Thank you for your kindness in making sure there is always someone here in church during Adoration time.

An FYI, when trying to reach a priest in an *emergency situation* to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
