



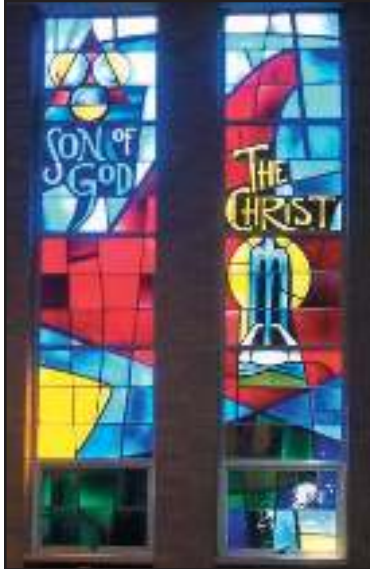

Beloved in Christ, as we gather on the Seventh Sunday of Easter, we are reminded of Jesus' profound Prayer for Unity in John 17:20-26, where He beseeches the Father, "that they may all be one." ## COMUNIDAD HISPANA

### Mensaje Del Parroco, P. John Tibakunirwa

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo: Al reflexionar sobre las Lecturas de hoy, encontramos un mensaje profundo sobre los caminos individuales en la fe, muy parecido al recorrido de la Iglesia primitiva descrito en los Hechos de los Apóstoles. Así como los primeros cristianos enfrentaron conflictos sobre la circuncisión y la Ley de Moisés, nosotros también nos encontramos con encrucijadas en nuestros caminos espirituales. Como un barco que navega por aguas tormentosas, el Espíritu Santo nos guía, como se evidencia en la decisión del Concilio de Jerusalén. El Salmo nos recuerda que «Dios tenga piedad de nosotros y nos bendiga», mostrando que nuestras vocaciones individuales —ya sea en la vida religiosa, en el matrimonio o en la vida célibe— son caminos iluminados por la gracia divina. El Evangelio de Juan nos ofrece la promesa de paz de Jesús, no como la da el mundo, sino una paz más profunda y duradera que viene al seguir sus Mandamientos. Esta paz es como un faro en la oscuridad, que nos guía hacia la Jerusalén Celestial descrita en el Apocalipsis, donde la presencia de Dios lo ilumina todo y no se necesita templo alguno. A medida que continúas tu camino vocacional único, recuerda que, al igual que los Apóstoles fueron guiados por el Espíritu Santo en decisiones cruciales, tu camino también está iluminado por la Sabiduría Divina, llevándote hacia esa Ciudad eterna donde la luz de Dios nunca se apaga.

La misa será a las 2:00 p.m., con salida de regreso a las 3:00 p.m.

El Papa Francisco inauguró y dio inicio al Año Jubilar 2025 con el lema: *"Peregrinos de la Esperanza"*.
