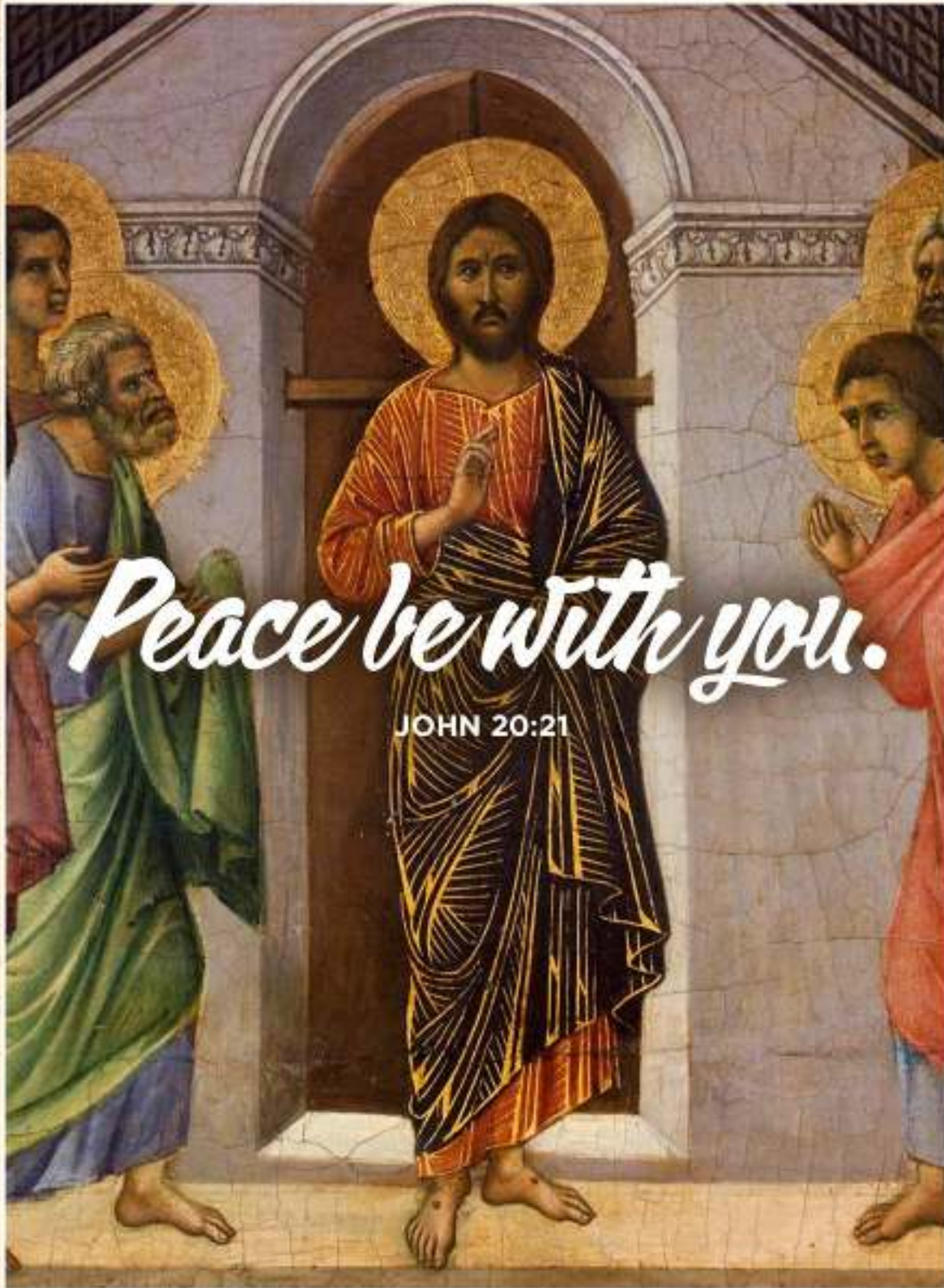




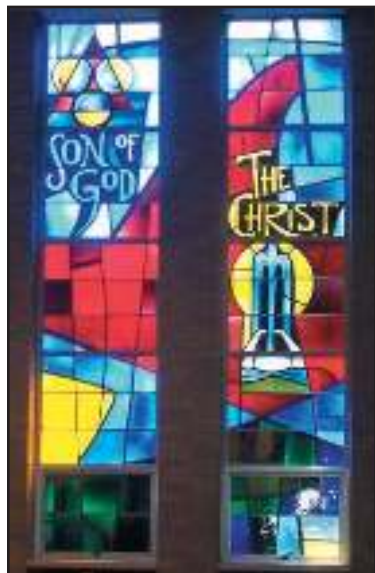

From Your Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As a mighty wind stirs the sea, so does the spirit move through our Community of Holy Name Church. This ancient proverb captures the essence of today's Pentecost readings. In Acts 2:1-11 we witness the dramatic descent of the Holy spirit manifesting as "tongues of fire" and enabling the apostles to speak in different languages. This extraordinary event mirrors our own Parish's journey-diverse in backgrounds and yet united in faith. Psalm 104 reminds us that when you send forth your spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the earth. Like a garden flourishing after spring rain our community blossoms when we open ourselves to the spirit's renewal. COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Mensaje Del Parroco, P. John Chrysostom Tibakunirwa

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo: Así como un viento poderoso agita el mar, también el Espíritu se mueve a través de nuestra comunidad de la Iglesia del Santo Nombre. Este antiguo proverbio captura la esencia de las lecturas de Pentecostés de hoy. En Hechos 2:1-11, somos testigos del dramático descenso del Espíritu Santo, manifestándose como "lenguas de fuego" y permitiendo a los apóstoles hablar en diferentes idiomas. Este acontecimiento extraordinario refleja el camino de nuestra propia parroquia: diversos en nuestros orígenes, pero unidos en la fe. El Salmo 104 nos recuerda que, cuando envías tu espíritu, son creados, y renuevas la faz de la tierra. Como un jardín que florece después de la lluvia de primavera, nuestra comunidad florece cuando nos abrimos a la renovación del Espíritu. Como dice el refrán: una sola flor no hace un jardín, pero juntas crean belleza. El mensaje de San Pablo en 1 Corintios 12 enfatiza que, a pesar de nuestros dones diferentes, somos un solo cuerpo en Cristo. Nadie puede decir: "Jesús es el Señor", sino por el Espíritu Santo. Como una sinfonía en la que cada instrumento toca su parte única para crear música armoniosa, nuestros diversos dones sirven al bien común de nuestra parroquia. En Juan 20:19-23, Jesús sopla sobre sus discípulos diciendo: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo". Este gesto íntimo, como el abrazo amoroso de un padre, nos capacita para la misión. Como dice el viejo adagio: donde habita el Espíritu, los corazones son transformados. Abracemos estas lecturas reconociendo nuestros dones únicos como regalos del Espíritu, celebrando nuestra unidad en la diversidad, usando nuestros dones para servir a los demás y siendo instrumentos de paz y reconciliación. Recuerden: el Espíritu, como el viento, es invisible, pero sus efectos son inconfundibles. Que seamos signos visibles de la presencia del Espíritu en nuestro mundo.
