

## From Your Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Coincidentally on this Solemnity of Holy Trinity we celebrate Father's Day. We gather to celebrate not only our earthly fathers but also to contemplate the profound Wisdom found in our Sacred Readings about God's divine Fatherhood. As we reflect on today's Readings, we discover beautiful connections between earthly fatherhood and Our Heavenly Father's Love.

In Proverbs 8:22 we hear wisdom speaking of being present "at the beginning of God's work." Like a father who carefully plans for his child's future, our Heavenly Father crafted creation with divine Wisdom. The passage tells us "When He established the Heavens, I was there." (Proverbs 8:27), reminding us that fatherhood like creation itself is part of God's master plan.

Psalm 8:4-9 poses the profound question, "What is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them? "This beautiful Psalm reminds us of our special place in creation, having been made" a little lower than the angels" and crowned with" glory and honor." Just as earthly fathers are called to be mindful of their children's needs, Our Heavenly Father remains eternally mindful of us.

In Romans 5:1-5, Paul speaks of how "suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; character, hope. "This mirrors the patient Wisdom of good fathers who understand that life's challenges help shape their children's character. Like a skilled craftsman, Our Heaven Father allows to grow through joys and trials.

Finally, in John 16:12-15, Jesus speaks of the Spirit of Truth who will Guide you into all Truth." This passage beautifully illustrates how the Father, Son and Holy Spirit work together in perfect harmony - a Model of earthly Fathers who are called to guide their children in Truth and Love. As we celebrate the Solemnity of Holy Trinity and Fathers today, let us remember that every act of genuine Fatherly love reflects the Divine love of Our Heavenly Father. May all Fathers be blessed with Wisdom, Patience and Grace as they fulfil their sacred Vocation.

# **COMUNIDAD HISPANA**

## Mensaje Del Parroco, Padre John Chrysostom Tibakunirwa

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Coincidentemente, en esta Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad celebramos el Día del Padre. Nos reunimos para celebrar no solo a nuestros padres terrenales, sino también para contemplar la profunda Sabiduría que encontramos en nuestras Lecturas Sagradas sobre la divina Paternidad de Dios. Al reflexionar sobre las lecturas de hoy, descubrimos hermosas conexiones entre la paternidad terrenal y el Amor de nuestro Padre Celestial. En Proverbios 8:22 escuchamos a la Sabiduría decir que estaba presente "al principio de la obra de Dios." Como un padre que planea cuidadosamente el futuro de su hijo, nuestro Padre Celestial creó el mundo con divina Sabiduría. El pasaje nos dice: "Cuando estableció los cielos, allí estaba yo." (Proverbios 8:27), recordándonos que la paternidad, como la creación misma, es parte del plan maestro de Dios. El Salmo 8:4-9 plantea la profunda pregunta: "¿Qué es el hombre para que te acuerdes de él, el ser humano para que lo tomes en cuenta?" Este hermoso salmo nos recuerda nuestro lugar especial en la creación, habiendo sido hechos "poco menor que los ángeles" y coronados de "gloria y honor." Así como los padres terrenales están llamados a estar atentos a las necesidades de sus hijos, nuestro Padre Celestial permanece eternamente atento a nosotros. En Romanos 5:1-5, Pablo habla de cómo "el sufrimiento produce perseverancia; la perseverancia, entereza de carácter; y la entereza de carácter, esperanza." Esto refleja la sabia paciencia de los buenos padres, que comprenden que los desafíos de la vida ayudan a formar el carácter de sus hijos. Como un artesano experto, nuestro Padre Celestial nos permite crecer a través de las alegrías y las pruebas. Finalmente, en Juan 16:12-15, Jesús habla del Espíritu de Verdad, quien "los quiará a toda la verdad." Este pasaje ilustra maravillosamente cómo el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo obran juntos en perfecta armonía — un modelo para los padres terrenales, que están llamados a guiar a sus hijos en la Verdad y el Amor.
