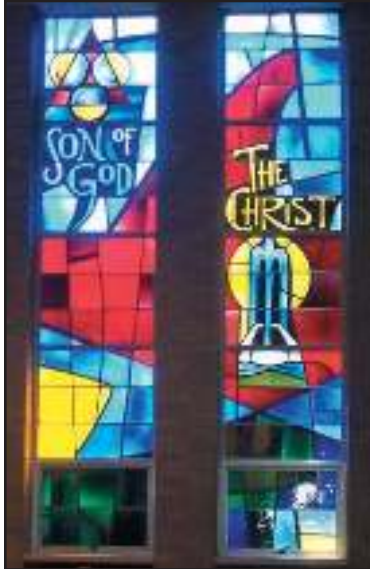

Message of the Week



From Your Pastor

Today we celebrate a very important Feast, namely The Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). This Feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this Feast is to meditate on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. Besides this, the People of God present are perceived as the Body of Christ in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with His disciples. He expresses this in the Gospels by using the metaphor of a Body in which He is the Head. This image helps keep in focus both the Unity and diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God Our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.

A reception will follow at the Social Center. All are welcome.

Eucharistic Adoration - 1-4p.m. on Tuesdays

The Chaplet will still be prayed at 3p.m. and the Rosary at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction.

When trying to reach a priest in an emergency situation to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 9:30a.m. All are invited!

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Mensaje Del Parroco, Padre John Chrysostom Tibakunirwa

Hoy celebramos una Fiesta muy importante: el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi). Esta Fiesta nos llama a centrarnos en dos manifestaciones del Cuerpo de Cristo: la Sagrada Eucaristía y la Iglesia. El propósito principal de esta celebración es meditar sobre la Eucaristía. La oración de apertura de la Misa dirige nuestra atención al sufrimiento y la muerte de Jesús, así como a nuestra adoración hacia Él, especialmente en la Eucaristía. En cada Misa, se nos recuerda la Eucaristía y la Presencia Real de Cristo en ella. Además, el Pueblo de Dios presente se percibe como el Cuerpo de Cristo en la Iglesia. La Iglesia es llamada el Cuerpo de Cristo debido a la íntima comunión que Jesús comparte con sus discípulos. Él expresa esto en los Evangelios utilizando la metáfora de un Cuerpo en el cual Él es la Cabeza. Esta imagen ayuda a mantener en perspectiva tanto la unidad como la diversidad de la Iglesia. La Fiesta de Corpus Christi suele ser una oportunidad para procesiones eucarísticas públicas, que sirven como signo de fe común y adoración. Nuestra adoración a Jesús en su Cuerpo y Sangre nos llama a ofrecer a Dios Padre una promesa de amor indiviso y una entrega de nosotros mismos al servicio de los demás.
