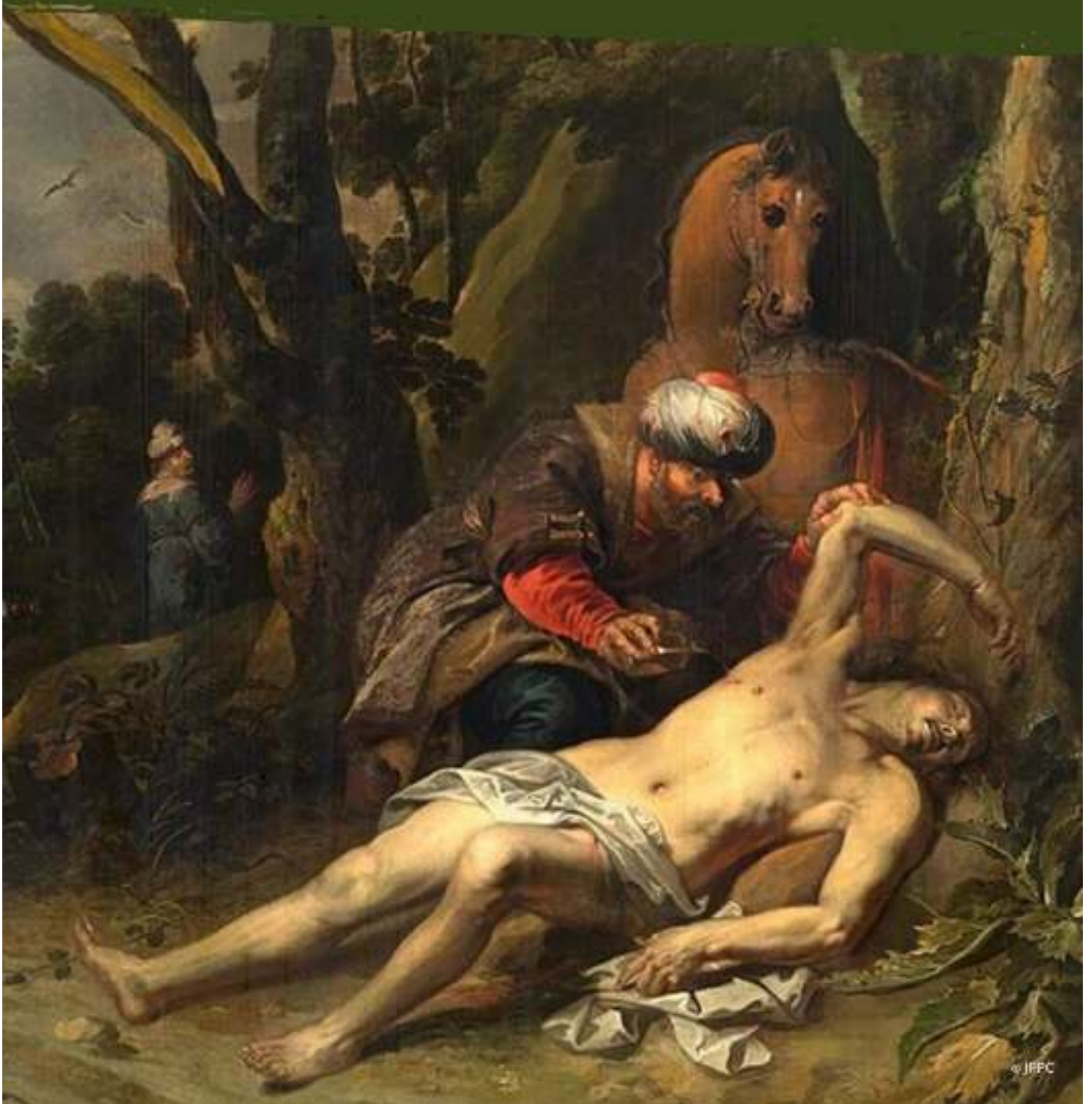

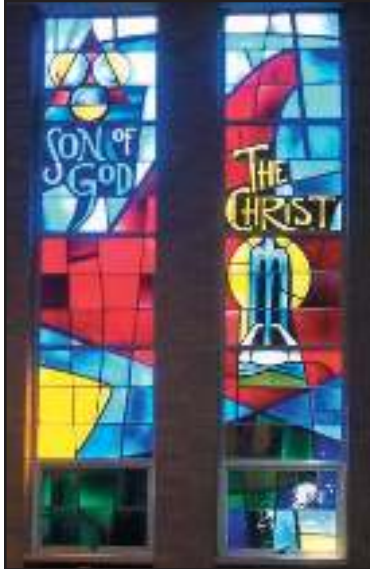

WORSHIP

From Your Pastor



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Scripture Readings beautifully interweave God's accessibility and our call to neighborly love. In the Book of Deuteronomy Moses reminds us that God's commandments are not distant or mysterious—they reside in our hearts and on our lips. As the Psalmist proclaims, "I pray You, O LORD, for the time of Your favor, O GOD" (Psalm 69:14), we are reminded that God's presence is immediate and constant.

The letter to the Colossians presents Christ as the image of the invisible God, "through whom all things were created and reconciled. This profound truth echoes the ancient wisdom." As above, so below"—Christ bridges Heaven and Earth, making Divine Presence tangible in our daily lives.

The Good Samaritan parable in Luke's Gospel exemplifies practical Christianity. Like the Samaritan who showed Mercy to the stranger, we're called to manifest God's Presence through concrete acts of love. As the proverb states, "actions speak louder than words."

Consider this: The command to love God and neighbor isn't merely a lofty ideal—it's as close as your heartbeat, as practical as biding a Stranger's wounds. The Divine Law isn't written in mysterious language, in some distant temple; it's inscribed in our daily interactions, our choices, our Responses to other's needs.

Let us pray: Lord help us recognize Your Presence in our daily lives and in the faces of those we meet. Grant us the wisdom to understand that Your commands are not burdensome but life-giving, and the courage to be Your hands and feet in this World. Amen

Remember: "The journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step." Today, it is in order to take that step in love.

Also, I want to let everyone know that I will be away for a few weeks. I am leaving on Sunday, July 13th and returning on Thursday, July 31st. Thanks to Bishop William Byrne and Very Rev. Piotr Calik for assuring the Masses and Confessions will be covered for the duration".

Eucharistic Adoration - 1-4p.m. on Tuesdays

The Chaplet will still be prayed at 3p.m. and the Rosary at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction.

When trying to reach a priest in an emergency situation to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approximately 9:30a.m. All are invited!

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Mensaje Del Pastor, John Chrysostom Tibakunirwa

Las lecturas bíblicas de hoy entrelazan hermosamente la accesibilidad de Dios con nuestro llamado al amor al prójimo. En el Libro del Deuteronomio, Moisés nos recuerda que los mandamientos de Dios no son distantes ni misteriosos: habitan en nuestro corazón y en nuestros labios. Como proclama el salmista: *“Pero yo te dirijo mi oración, Señor, en el tiempo de tu favor, oh Dios”* (Salmo 69:14), se nos recuerda que la presencia de Dios es inmediata y constante. La carta a los Colosenses presenta a Cristo como la imagen del Dios invisible, *“por quien todo fue creado y reconciliado.”* Esta profunda verdad resuena con la sabiduría antigua: *“Como es arriba, es abajo”* —Cristo es el puente entre el Cielo y la Tierra, haciendo tangible la Presencia Divina en nuestra vida cotidiana. La parábola del Buen Samaritano en el Evangelio de Lucas ejemplifica el cristianismo práctico. Al igual que el samaritano que mostró misericordia al desconocido, nosotros estamos llamados a manifestar la presencia de Dios a través de actos concretos de amor. Como dice el proverbio:

“Las acciones hablan más que las palabras.”

Reflexiona en esto: El mandato de amar a Dios y al prójimo no es simplemente un ideal elevado—es tan cercano como los latidos de tu corazón, tan práctico como vendar las heridas de un extraño. La Ley Divina no está escrita en un lenguaje misterioso ni en un templo lejano; está inscrita en nuestras interacciones diarias, en nuestras decisiones, en nuestras respuestas a las necesidades del otro.

Oremos: Señor, ayúdanos a reconocer Tu presencia en nuestra vida diaria y en los rostros de quienes encontramos. Concédenos la sabiduría para comprender que tus mandamientos no son una carga, sino una fuente de vida, y la valentía para ser tus manos y tus pies en este mundo. Amén. **Recuerda:** *“El viaje de mil millas comienza con un solo paso.”* Hoy es el día para dar ese paso... con amor.

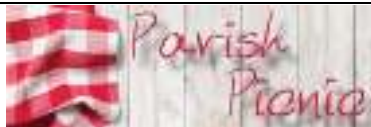
