

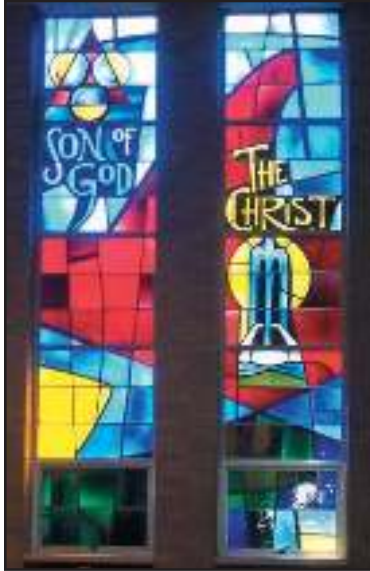

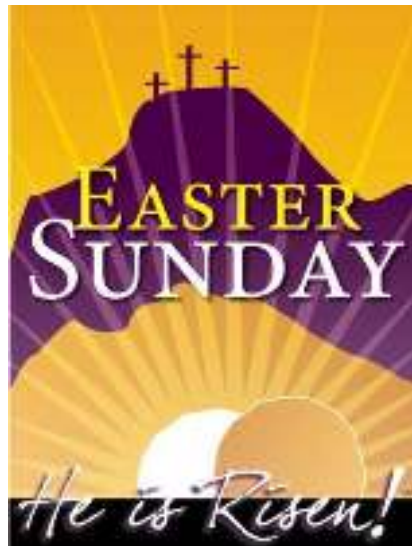

From Your Pastor



My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, today we rejoice with the whole Church, for the tomb is empty and death has been defeated. This Easter and Always I thank God for each of you - the living stones of our Parish. Together we have journeyed through the Cross to the empty tomb, and now we share in the victory of Christ. The stone rolled away is the doorway to eternity, and the Risen Christ is the light that will never fade. I encourage you step into that light with courage. Let it warm your heart, heal your wounds, guide your steps. Let us be witnesses of His love in our neighborhoods, workplaces, families, Our Parish and Our World. May the hope of Easter renew your heart and conscience and strengthen your faith.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION is on Tuesdays, 1:00 to 4:00p.m.

The Chaplet is prayed at 3p.m., the Rosary is prayed at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approx. 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

When trying to reach a priest in an **emergency situation** to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital - if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.

Easter Sunday - April 5, 2026 *"He is not here; for He has risen."* (Matthew 28:6)

Christ's resurrection opens the way to new life and hope for all who follow Him. Through priesthood and consecrated life, men and women share in this victory over sin and death, bringing the joy of the Risen Lord to others through prayer and service.
