

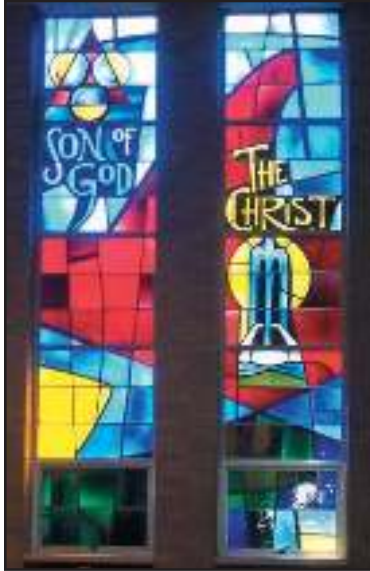

THESE WORDS ARE A PROMISE OF ENDURING PRESENCE AND SUPPORT. HE IS FULLY AWARE AND KNOWS OUR FEARS AND ASSURES US THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT THE ADVOCATE IS WITH US ALWAYS TO GUIDE US, TO TEACH US AND TO INSPIRE US IN VARIOUS MOMENTS OF OUR LIVES. LOVING JESUS THEN BECOMES IMPORTANT SO MUCH SO THAT DOING THIS MEANS LIVING HIS COMMANDMENTS: FORGIVING, SERVING, SPEAKING THE TRUTH. WE CAN NOT DO THIS ALONE, BUT THE SPIRIT GIVES US STRENGTH AND GUIDANCE. WITHOUT DOUBTS THE SPIRIT ABIDES BOTH WITH THE CHURCH AND WITHIN EACH ONE OF US AS DEDICATED BELIEVERS, MAKING US TEMPLES OF GOD'S PRESENCE AND EMPOWERING US TO LIVE OUR CHRISTIAN CALLING FAITHFULLY.
