



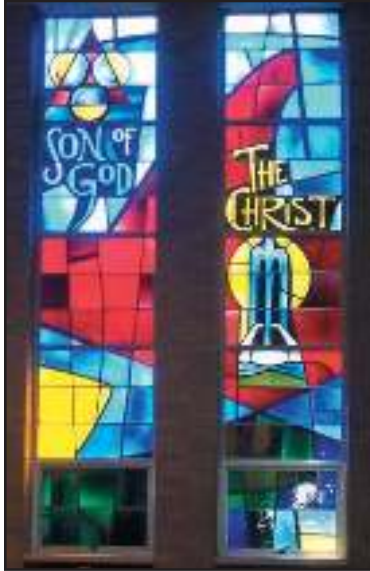

WORSHIP

From Your Pastor



THIS WEEKEND WE GET TO CELEBRATE THE SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER. THE READINGS PREPARE US IN A PRAYERFUL WAITING MODE FOR THE FEAST OF PENTECOST. ON THE OUTSET, THE BOOK OF ACTS 1:12-14 MARKS THE TRANSITION FROM JESUS EARTHLY MINISTRY TO THE MISSION OF THE CHURCH. IT PORTRAYS THE DISCIPLES' UNITY, DEVOTION AND ANTICIPATION, WHILE GROUNDING THE NARRATIVE IN HISTORICAL AND GEOGRAPHICAL DETAIL. THEOLOGICALLY IT SETS THE STAGE FOR PENTECOST AND THE OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, UNDERSCORING THE IMPORTANCE OF PRAYER, COMMUNITY AND TRUST IN GOD'S TIMING. IN THE GOSPEL OF SAINT JOHN 17:1-11 WE LEARN OF CHRIST'S HIGH PRIESTLY PRAYER. WHAT JESUS DOES IS: HE LIFTS HIS EYES TO HEAVEN AND INTERCEDES BEFORE THE FATHER ON THE EVE OF HIS CRUCIFIXION. THIS PRAYER REVEALS THE DEPTH OF HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD AND HIS MISSION FOR THE WORLD. FIRST, HE PRAYS FOR HIMSELF- NOT IN SELFISHNESS, BUT THAT THE FATHER WOULD GLORIFY HIM SO THAT HE MIGHT GLORIFY THE FATHER THROUGH THE COMPLETION OF HIS REDEMPTIVE WORK. THEN HE TURNS TO HIS DISCIPLES, ASKING FOR THEIR PROTECTION, UNITY AND SANCTIFICATION IN THE TRUTH. FINALLY HIS PRAYER EXTENDS BEYOND HIS IMMEDIATE CIRCLE TO ALL FUTURE BELIEVERS, EXPRESSING HIS DESIRE THAT THEY MAY BE ONE, JUST AS HE AND THE FATHER ARE ONE SO THAT THE WORLD MAY BELIEVE. THIS PASSAGE TRULY UNVEILS THE ETERNAL LOVE BETWEEN FATHER AND SON, THE MEDIATING ROLE OF CHRIST AND THE HEART OF GOD FOR HIS PEOPLE. IN IT, WE SEE JESUS NOT ONLY AS SAVIOR AND TEACHER, BUT AS THE HIGH PRIEST WHO CARRIES US HIS PEOPLE INTO THE PRESENCE OF GOD.

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Mensaje Del Padre John Chrisostom Tibakunirwa

Este fin de semana celebramos el Séptimo Domingo de Pascua. Las lecturas nos preparan en un espíritu de espera y oración para la Fiesta de Pentecostés. Al comienzo, el Libro de los Hechos 1:12-14 marca la transición del ministerio terrenal de Jesús hacia la misión de la Iglesia. Presenta la unidad, la devoción y la esperanza de los discípulos, mientras sitúa la narrativa en un contexto histórico y geográfico. Teológicamente, prepara el camino para Pentecostés y el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo, subrayando la importancia de la oración, la comunidad y la confianza en el tiempo de Dios. En el Evangelio de San Juan 17:1-11 aprendemos sobre la Oración Sacerdotal de Cristo. Jesús levanta sus ojos al cielo e intercede ante el Padre en la víspera de su crucifixión. Esta oración revela la profundidad de su relación con Dios y su misión para el mundo. Primero, ora por sí mismo, no por egoísmo, sino para que el Padre lo glorifique y así Él pueda glorificar al Padre mediante el cumplimiento de su obra redentora. Luego se dirige a sus discípulos, pidiendo por su protección, unidad y santificación en la verdad. Finalmente, su oración se extiende más allá de su círculo inmediato hacia todos los futuros creyentes, expresando su deseo de que todos sean uno, así como Él y el Padre son uno, para que el mundo crea. Este pasaje revela verdaderamente el amor eterno entre el Padre y el Hijo, el papel mediador de Cristo y el corazón de Dios para su pueblo. En él vemos a Jesús no solo como Salvador y Maestro, sino como el Sumo Sacerdote que nos lleva, a nosotros su pueblo, a la presencia de Dios.
