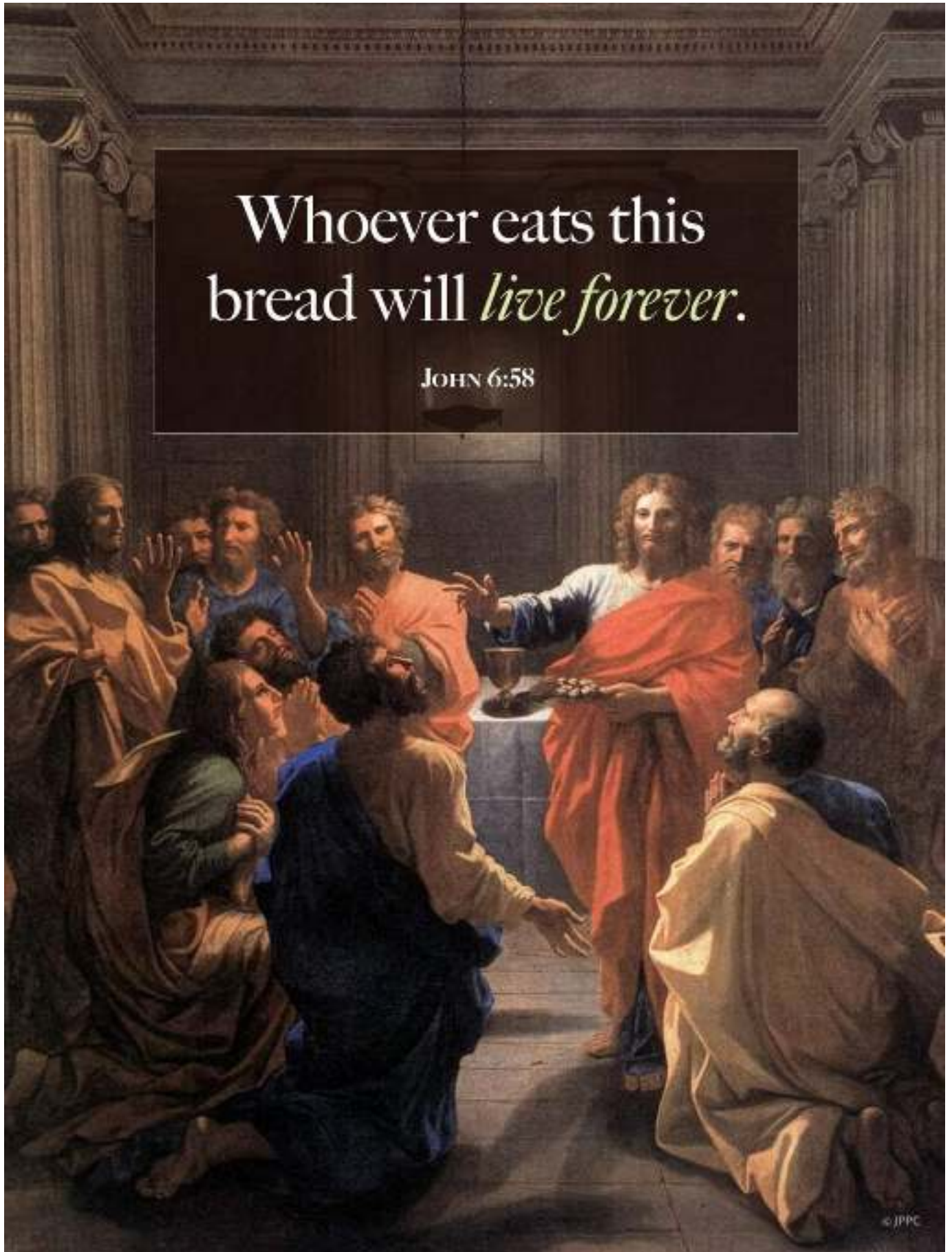

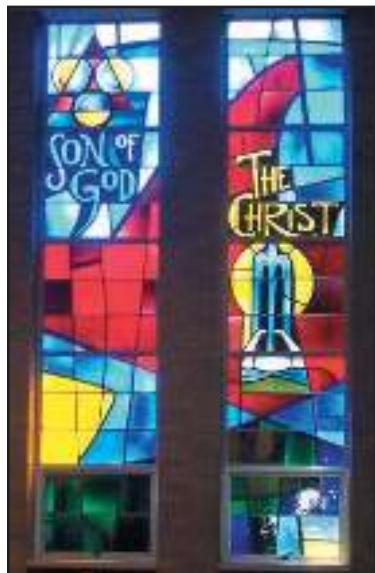

Message of the Week



DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

The Readings We hear proclaimed to us On this Day Of Our Lord, help us build Our Faith from Our Hearts and Consciences while appreciating the Mystery of the Eucharist. In the Book of Deuteronomy 8:2-3.14-16, Moses reminds Israel to remember the God who fed them with Manna in the Desert, a Bread Unknown to their Ancestors. This was not just nourishment for the Body, but a sign of God's Faithful Presence. In the Gospel of John 6:51-58, Jesus reveals the Fulfillment of that Sign: I am the Living Bread that came down from Heaven... and the Bread that I will give is my Flesh for the Life of the World. Here, He is not speaking in Symbols alone-- He is Offering Himself, Body and Blood, as True Spiritual Food and True Spiritual Drink. Saint Paul, in 1 Corinthians 10:16-17, tells us that when we share the One Bread, We Become One Body. The Eucharist is not only Christ's Gift to Us: It is the Bond that makes Us His Body, the Church. Every time we approach this Altar, We are not merely remembering an event--We are entering into It. The same Christ who fed the Multitudes, who gave Himself on the Cross, Who Rose from the Dead, is Here, truly present. Let us come to this Altar of the Lord with hearts full of gratitude, aware that in receiving Him, We are called to become what we receive--- His Living Presence in the World. May Our Lives proclaim the Love we have tasted in this Sacrament.

The Chaplet is prayed at 3p.m., the Rosary is prayed at 3:30p.m.
followed by Benediction.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approx. 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

When trying to reach a priest in an **emergency situation** to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
