



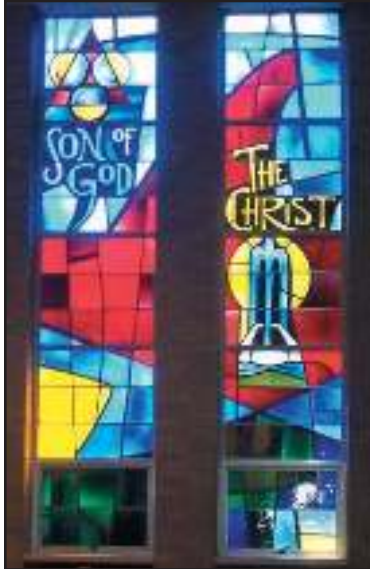

# WORSHIP

## From Your Pastor



The content of today's Readings bring to us give us a solid message we can use for a lifetime. In them we learn that God speaks to us about courage, trust and the boundless gifts of His grace. The Prophet Jeremiah, (Jeremiah 20:10-13) cries out from a place of deep trial: I hear the whisperings of many: Terror on every side! Denounce Him. Let us denounce Him. Yet, He proclaims with unshakeable faith. The Lord is with me, like a mighty champion. Even in betrayal and fear, Jeremiah's confidence rests in God's justice and protection. The Psalmist in Psalm 69:8-10.17.33-35 echoes that trust: For your sake, I bear insult, and shame covers my face. In your great kindness, answer me with your constant help, o God. This is the prayer of every believer who suffers for righteousness- a reminder that God hears the cries of the poor and never abandon His Own. In the Gospel, Jesus tells us in Matthew 10:26-33 Do not be afraid of them...even the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid you are worth more than many sparrows. He calls us to fearless witness, assuring us that whoever acknowledges Him before others will be acknowledged before the Father. Last but not least, Romans 5:12-15 reminds us of the foundation of our hope: Through one man sin entered the World. But the gift is not like the transgression. The grace of God and the gracious gift of the one Man Jesus Christ overflow for the many. Our courage is not rooted in our own strength, but in the saving, grace poured through Christ. Today the word invites us to live boldly for the Gospel, to Trust God's providence in trials and to remember that His grace is greater than any fear. Let us, like Jeremiah and the Psalmist, stand firm knowing that in Christ we are never alone. In a special way, I take a moment to wish you well on Father's Day. This Weekend we do not just celebrate a date on the Calendar, we celebrate you, the fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers, uncles, and spiritual mentors who make up the backbone of Our Holy Name Church Family of the people God. Thank you for the quiet, unseen ways you serve. Thank you for the late nights, the hard work, the prayers whispered in secret, and the steady examples of faith you provide. In a World that constantly changes, your commitments to walking with integrity and leading with love is a powerful anchor for the next generation.

## COMUNIDAD HISPANA

### **Mensaje Del Padre John Chrysostom Tibakunirwa**

El contenido de las Lecturas de hoy nos trae un mensaje sólido que podemos usar durante toda la vida. En ellas aprendemos que Dios nos habla sobre el valor, la confianza y el don ilimitado de Su gracia. El profeta Jeremías (Jeremías 20:10-13) clama desde un lugar de profunda prueba: «Oigo los murmullos de muchos: “¡Terror por todas partes! ¡Denúncienlo! ¡Vamos a denunciarlo!”». Sin embargo, proclama con una fe inquebrantable: «El Señor está conmigo como un poderoso campeón». Incluso en medio de la traición y el miedo, la confianza de Jeremías descansa en la justicia y protección de Dios. El salmista, en el Salmo 69:8-10, 17, 33-35, hace eco de esa confianza: «Por tu causa soporto insultos y la vergüenza cubre mi rostro. En tu gran bondad respóndeme con tu ayuda constante, oh Dios». Esta es la oración de todo creyente que sufre por la justicia, un recordatorio de que Dios escucha el clamor de los pobres y nunca abandona a los suyos. En el Evangelio, Jesús nos dice en Mateo 10:26-33: «No les tengan miedo... hasta los cabellos de su cabeza están contados. Así que no teman; ustedes valen más que muchos gorriones». Él nos llama a dar testimonio sin temor, asegurándonos que quien lo reconozca delante de los demás será reconocido ante el Padre. Por último, pero no menos importante, Romanos 5:12-15 nos recuerda el fundamento de nuestra esperanza: «Por un solo hombre entró el pecado en el mundo. Pero el don no es como la transgresión. La gracia de Dios y el generoso don de un solo Hombre, Jesucristo, se han desbordado para muchos». Nuestro valor no se basa en nuestra propia fuerza, sino en la gracia salvadora derramada por Cristo. Hoy, la Palabra nos invita a vivir con valentía por el Evangelio, a confiar en la providencia de Dios en medio de las pruebas y a recordar que Su gracia es más grande que cualquier temor. Que nosotros, al igual que Jeremías y el salmista, permanezcamos firmes sabiendo que en Cristo nunca estamos solos. De manera especial, quiero tomar un momento para desearles un feliz Día de los Padres. Este fin de semana no solo celebramos una fecha en el calendario; los celebramos a ustedes: padres, abuelos, padrastros, tíos y mentores espirituales que constituyen la columna vertebral de nuestra familia parroquial de Holy Name, el pueblo de Dios. Gracias por las maneras silenciosas y muchas veces invisibles en que sirven. Gracias por las noches largas, el trabajo arduo, las oraciones susurradas en secreto y el ejemplo constante de fe que ofrecen. En un mundo que cambia constantemente, su compromiso de caminar con integridad y liderar con amor es un poderoso ancla para la próxima generación.
