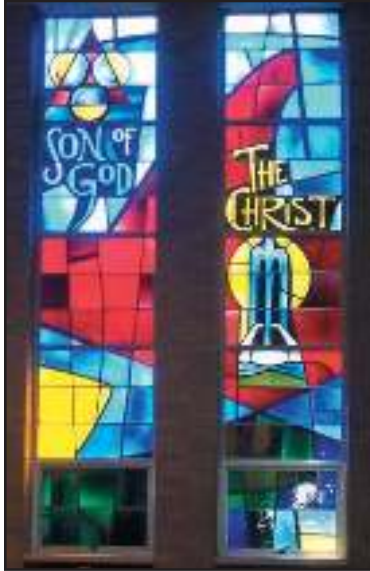

Message of the Week



Beloved of God, we gather to celebrate the 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time. In Matthew 11:25-30 we learn Jesus invites the humble to find rest in him. Like a tired traveler who drops a heavy pack at the foot of a cool stream, Jesus says, come to me, and I will give you rest. The burdens we carry- worry, pride, the push to prove ourselves- are like stones in our packs. Jesus offers a gentle yoke: not a load that crushes, but a harness that helps us walk together. In that companionship, strength becomes peace. Lay your stones down; learn from him; find rest for your soul.

This Weekend we coincidentally celebrate American Independence. As a Church we affirm that the Continent's future is safest when guided by Divine love- a love that calls for unity, humility and service for the common good of all people. To that end we let us pray for our Continent.



Is on Tuesdays, 1:00 to 4:00p.m.

The Chaplet is prayed at 3p.m., the Rosary is prayed at 3:30p.m. followed by Benediction. Please come join us if you can.

On the first Saturday of every month, the **Blue Army** group follows the 8:15a.m. Mass with a rosary, meditation on the mysteries and confession until approx. 10:30a.m. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass to take part.

When trying to reach a priest in an **emergency situation** to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** for someone in the hospital – if a parish priest isn't immediately available and time is critical, there should be a Chaplain available 24/7 at each of the area hospitals.
